
The Valplast Guarantee

Valplast dentures are guaranteed against fracture of the pink flexible base assuming normal use. The guarantee will be honoured indefinitely provided that you retain the certificate of authenticity. The guarantee applies to material defect of the resin provided that there are no post-insertion modifications made by the patient. It does not guarantee; the artificial teeth, bond between the teeth and base, colour of the base and the fit of the appliance.

Do I need a special cleaner?

FDC Flexible Denture cleaner and Val-Clean are available from Ilfracombe Dental practice. We do not stock it but can order it in for you on request. Please allow at least 2 days for delivery. This cleaner is designed not to chemically damage the nylon material.



Can shop bought cleaners work on my Valplast Denture?

Proprietary brands of denture cleaner are not recommended for cleaning Valplast appliances. They MAY contain ingredients that could damage the Valplast or its colour.

Can I have a tooth added to my Valplast appliance?

Yes you can. The appliance will be sent to a certified Valplast laboratory to have a tooth or teeth added to it. An impression of your mouth is required and you will be without your appliance for a few days whilst the addition is being made. Valplast can do everything a normal rigid denture can do and more. Ask your dentist about how Vaplast can improve your smile.

Why choose a Valplast Partial Dentures/Prosthesis?

Any removable prosthesis can be an alternative to Bridgework and implants or a temporary solution to no teeth whilst being treated for implants or bridgework. This is because the mouth remains unaltered as only simple impressions of the mouth are needed to fabricate a prosthesis.

Valplast flexible partials could be the solution for you to replace one or more teeth. Unlike most traditional rigid dentures, Valplast dentures are made from a flexible plastic material. This enables these dentures to fit neatly into your mouth and are virtually invisible. They do not require any unsightly metal clasps to keep them in place. Because of their flexibility, they are able to lock firmly into the mouth by engaging into natural contours of surrounding teeth and gums. This has two advantages, no clasps as previously mentioned but it also eliminates areas in the mouth where food can collect between tooth and appliance.
